- Am I clear about which prescriptions to take and which ones are discontinued?
 - Do I have all the prescriptions I need?
- Am I able to keep my family up-to-date on my condition?
 - Do I know who to call day and/or night if problems arise?
- Will I need help in the home with ...
 - additional personal assistance in the home (bathing, dressing, in and out of bed, toileting, etc.)?
 - grocery shopping?
 - meal preparation?
 - laundry and light housekeeping?
